

ENLIGHTENED HEART CHOKER



MATERIALS:

- 1 pink-purple 25mm photobead with asters and chrysanthemums
- 1 crystal heart charm
- 270 black seed beads
- 270 mixed red, dark red and pink seed beads
- 120 small garnet nuggets
- 3 coils of necklace memory wire 40cm (16") each
- 4 silver plated 6mm jump rings
- 2 silver plated 4mm jump rings
- 1 round part of a silver plated 13mm toggle clasp (you will not need the t-bar for this project)
- 1 silver plated lobster clasp
- 1 silver plated eye pin

TOOLS:

- Round nose pliers
- Flat nose pliers
- Wire cutters

FINISHED SIZE: 39cm (15")

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Make a loop on one end of a necklace memory wire coil. String all black seeds and make a loop to finish off the coil. Repeat this with a coil of garnet stones and a coil of red and pink seed beads.
2. Put the coils together and connect the three loops of one side together using a 6mm jump ring. Use another 6mm jump ring to attach the lobster clasp to the choker. Slightly twist the coils and connect the loops on the other side using another 6mm jump ring. Attach another 6mm jump ring.
3. Attach the crystal heart charm to the eye of the eye pin using one 4mm jump ring. String the photobead on the eye pin. Using your round nose pliers make a loop attaching the bead to the round part of a toggle clasp.
4. Slide the heart pendant onto the choker.
