

DAHLIA WREATH NECKLACE



MATERIALS:

- 16 ceramic 25mm Bloomy Coins with a red dahlia
- 17 red 10mm glass beads decorated with golden stripes
- 1m (40") of white 25mm organza ribbon
- 53cm (22") beading wire
- 2 silver plated 6mm split rings
- 2 silver plated crimp beads

TOOLS: flat nose pliers, wire cutters, crimp pliers

FINISHED SIZE: 50cm (20")

RESOURCES: check your local bead store or contact Photobeads (wholesale only), www.photobeads.eu

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Attach the wire to one split ring using one crimp bead.
2. String one red glass bead. String one dahlia bead and one red glass bead, repeat this until you have strung all beads.
3. Using one crimp bead attach the rest of the beading wire to the second jump ring.
4. Cut the ribbon in two halves and tie the halves to the jump rings. Replace the ribbons by a lobster clasp for a more casual look.
