

MOTHER'S GARDEN BRACELET



MATERIALS:

6 Royal Garden photobeads with roses
2 white 10mm glass flower cone beads
2 metal 10x7mm red rose beads
2 glass 8mm brass coloured faceted beads
1 glass 8mm red faceted bead
12 brass 16mm filigree bead caps
4 brass 7,5mm ornate bead caps

1 brass butterfly charm
1 brass scarab charm
1 brass filigree butterfly charm
1 brass leaf toggle bar
1 brass small leaf toggle ring
8 brass head pins
6 brass eye pins
12 brass 6mm jump rings

TOOLS: pliers,
round nose pliers,
wire cutters

FINISHED SIZE:
23cm (9")

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Spread two 16mm bead caps to fit a photobead. On an eye pin string one bead cap, one photobead and one bead cap; make a simple loop and cut excess wire. Repeat this with all the photobeads.
2. Use 5 jump rings to connect all the photobeads and form a bracelet.
3. Use one jump ring to connect the toggle ring to one end of the bracelet.
4. String the toggle bar on a head pin, make a simple loop very close to the bar and cut excess wire. Attach the bar to the other end of the bracelet using a chain made of three jump rings connected end to end.
5. String all the beads on head pins. String one ornate bead cup on each headpin with a flower bead. String the charms on jump rings.
6. Divide the beads and the charms randomly into five couples. Attach each couple to a jump ring between two photobeads by closing the jump rings with brass charms or forming simple loops at the end of the head pins with beads.



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
