

## SILVER BLOOM BRACELET



### MATERIALS:

- 4 Bloomy Coins photobeads with red dahlia
  - 7 glass 8mm smoky grey faceted beads
  - 2 glass 8mm red faceted beads
  - 13 silver coloured 3mm glass beads
  - 20 silver coloured 3mm glass cube beads
  - 3 silver coloured cube shaped seed beads
  - 1 silver coloured 25mm flower shaped toggle clasp
  - 1 silver coloured 20mm dragon fly charm
  - 4 silver coloured 5mm jump rings
  - 36cm silver coloured beading wire
  - 3 silver coloured crimp beads
- TOOLS: pliers, wire cutters, crimping pliers
- FINISHED SIZE: 20cm

### INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Bend the beading wire in half and slide a closed jump ring to the bend. String a crimp bead on both wire strings and place it as close to the jump ring as possible; crimp.
2. On both wire strings string a silver coloured 3mm glass bead and a photobead; repeat this four times. String one more silver coloured bead and split the wire strings.
3. String one silver coloured 3mm glass bead and one grey faceted bead on one wire string. Repeat this six times. String one silver coloured bead, one crimp bead, pass the wire through the eye of the flower part of the clasp and back through the crimp bead; crimp.
4. String the three cube seed beads, six cube glass beads, one red faceted bead, nine cube glass beads, one red faceted bead, five cube beads and one crimp bead on the other wire string. Pass the wire through the eye of the flower part of the clasp and back through the crimp bead; crimp.
5. Use a jump ring to connect the bar of the clasp to the free end of the bracelet.
6. Using two jump rings connected end to end to attach the dragon fly charm at the place where the wire strings split.

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
