

## INDIAN SUMMER NEECKLACE

As seen in Bead Unique (Fall 2009 issue)



### MATERIALS:

1 BeautyFall 45mm bamboo wood pendant with orange autumn leaves  
68 small Baltic amber chips  
260 seed beads in mixed colors: red, orange and light brown  
28 ¼ in. brass colored chain with small links  
2yd. 8 ¼ of novelty yarn with a rich texture

20 semi-transparent orange and brown 7mm glass tire shaped beads  
3 semi-transparent orange 10mm glass beads  
3 copper colored 20mm leaf shaped charms  
28 ¼ in. beading wire  
21 brass colored head pins  
11 brass colored 6mm jump rings  
2 brass colored fold over end caps  
2 crimp beads  
1 brass colored lobster clasp

FINISHED SIZE: 70cm (27 1/4in)

TOOLS: flat nose pliers, round nose pliers, wire cutters, scissors

### INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Use the beading wire to string 1 crimp bead and one jump ring; pass through the bead and crimp. String one orange or brown tire shaped bead and four seed beads. String one amber chip and four seed beads; repeat until you have no more amber chips or seed beads left. String one orange or brown tire shaped bead, one crimp bead, and a jump ring; pass back through the crimp bead, crimp and cut excess wire.
2. Cut a piece of 1 ¾ in. from the chain and put it aside. You will need it later to attach the pendant. String all the glass beads on the head pins. Distribute the beads and the leaf charms (face up) equally over the chain leaving 3 ½" from both sides and 1" in the center of the chain free. Attach the beads to the chain with a simple loop; use jump rings to attach the charms to the chain.
3. Cut the yarn in three equal pieces. Gather the yard ends and insert them in a fold over end cap; fold the flaps and press firmly. Repeat this on the other end.
4. Lay all the layers stretched out on a table. Use one jump ring to connect the layers together on one end; using one more jump ring attach the clasp. Shuffle the layers slightly and use a jump ring to connect the layers together on the other side. Attach one more jump ring.
5. Wrap the 1 ¾ in. chain piece around the center of the necklace to form a bail for the pendant. Using the last jump ring, connect both sides of the chain and the pendant.
